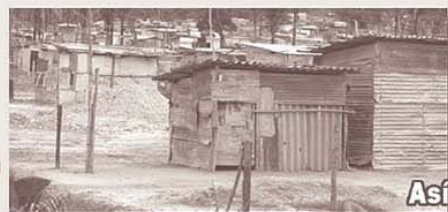

Well, and his socialist and communist pal Fidel only wears Adidas... the icon of capitalism in sports... The funniest thing is, those outfits are for athletes, active people,

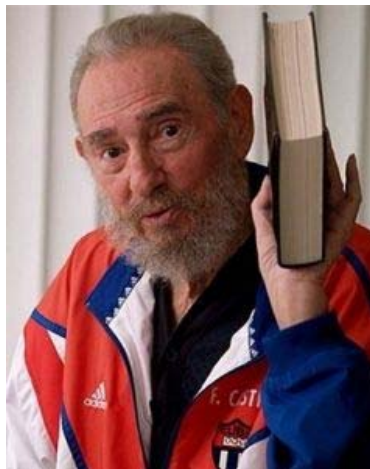
people who exercise... the only part of that walking cadaver that exercise is his finger... always reprimanding and always sentencing...

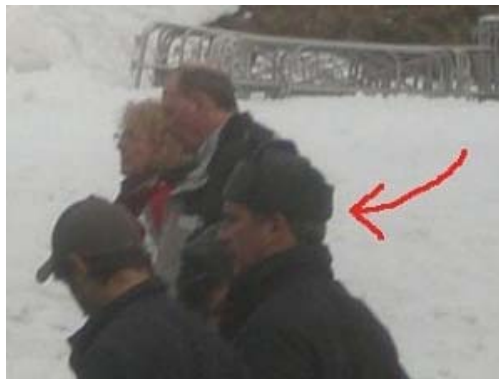

“Tragedy in Clarines”

“On September 18, 2009, the emergency room at the Clarines Hospital, in Anzoátegui State, collapsed with the arrival of many patients affected by intoxication. 9 people died by inhaling chlorine gas which escaped from a truck when it collided with a bus on the Clarines highway – El Hatillo, via Boca de Uchire, Mini Finca area. The truck that carried the chemical flipped over and the liquid gas spread over the road leaving around 100 people affected. The toxic gas affected the surrounding areas and towns close by to where the toxic gases extended.”

Due to the spreading out of the toxic gas, approximately 326 people were affected, 9 of which died from poisoning.

In Venezuela there are no laws to protect the citizens, there are no municipal or state codes to follow to take precautions, there is not even a law that forces people to check the smog of their vehicles, let alone more complicated laws for the transportation of toxic chemicals, etc. You are on your own because this is the land of the toughest.

2.- “Until when are we going to allow poor people and their children to starve? Until when are we going to let children die due to curable diseases? Until when are we going to allow armed struggles...?” Hugo Chávez Frías

The children on the streets from 11 years ago are now adult criminals. Those who were not that lucky, died because of crimes or starvation. The children living on the streets now are other children. They are all 11 years old or younger... do the math.

- **The Venezuelan regime will build 2,000 houses for the Dominican province of Montecristito benefit poor families in the area**
- **He gave to Cuba almost \$1,500 millions in 2009 alone**
- **He gave \$18 millions to Nicaragua to replace the pine groves tore down two years ago by the Caribbean cyclone**
- **He gave 6 Mirage airplanes to Ecuador**
- **He gave numerous anti-riot equipment to the Bolivian police**
- **He will finance the first phase of the Pacific Plain Irrigation project in Nicaragua, investment calculated at more than \$2,145 millions**
- **He gave to Bolivia \$80 millions through PDVSA (Venezuelan Oil Company) and ENDE (Venezuelan Electric Company) to install a thermoelectric plant in an area of the Cochabamba province**
- **He gave the ‘Simon Bolivar’ neighborhood subdivision in Mali, West Africa to the Mission Habitat Foundation, a 100 dwelling housing complex**

But beside that, the part that hurts the most is the wasting of the country’s money on weapons. Until when are we going to let this sick being buy more weapons than food, more battle tanks and rifles than medicine for the country? Insane dictator, you have no shame. You talk about your great peaceful revolution when it is armed to the teeth. Never in the history of Venezuela there had been so much violence on the streets. Today, anybody has fire arms because in Venezuela there are laws and punishment only for the dumb opposition.

Since 2005, Chavez has bought, with Venezuela’s money, more than \$4,000 million Russian weapons, among them 24 Sukhoi fighters, dozens of combat helicopters and 100.000 Kalashnikov assault rifles. Russia announced that in September they opened a line of credit for \$2,200 millions so Venezuela can buy more armament, including land-air missiles. Chavez said that *“more than 300 shielded cars and war tanks are going to start to arrive from Russia, including T-72 combat tanks. The radars and air defense systems started to arrive already”* as stated on November 23, 2009.

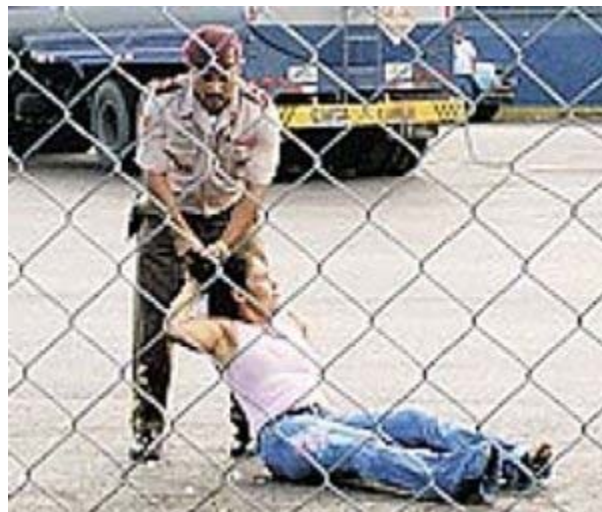

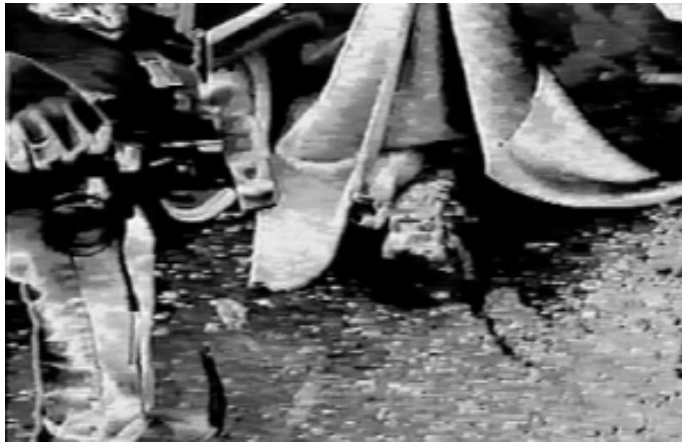

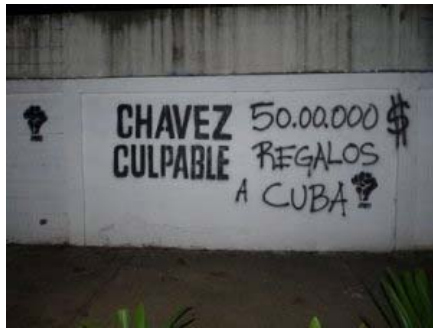
\$76.67 (price per barrel when this research was done) x 1,500,000 barrels = \$115.005.000. So, that means that Venezuela makes the modest sum of \$115 millions through it sells to US alone.

But even though this number is high, the truth is, Venezuela is only one of the 15 countries that sell oil to US. The first one or the one that sells the most oil to US is Canada, the second one is Mexico, the third one is Saudi Arabia and the fourth one is Venezuela. In other words, US doesn’t need to buy oil from Venezuela but Venezuela, being a country with an economy based only on the production of oil, does need to sell those millions of barrels a day to US, which, as mentioned before, represents 60% of the total oil sells for Venezuela. Without that income, I don’t know what Chavez would do because that is practically all he has coming in, his allowance. It is true that he wastes that money buying people off and not helping Venezuela (“his friends” according to him... if it wasn’t for the money he pays, he would have no one because the only reason people put up with him is the fact that he has petrodollars and a loose checkbook) but if US stopped buying oil from Venezuela, (let us pray to God for that), that would be the end for Chavez. Well, he is a despicable being who only has horrible things to say about US, we all know that, an he might kiss US’ ass behind closed doors, who knows...
